Each year, the Monroe County 4-H Committee raises money to support our local 4-H program. Part of the money they raise goes to providing 4-H members with amazing opportunities to take part in trips and camps throughout Ohio. Several other organizations also provide financial support for these camps. Youth may apply for any camps that they qualify to attend. Selections will be made on a first-come, first-served basis until all designated funds are used. If you are selected to attend a camp, you will be notified and required to submit a **non-refundable \$25 deposit** to hold your spot. Campers are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from camp locations. Please note that some dates overlap with Monroe County 4-H Camp dates which is beyond our control.

___ **State 4-H Leadership Camp** at 4-H Camp Ohio, Utica (June 1-5)

(Up to 2 recipients selected, must be at least 14 years old)

- ☼ Ohio 4-H Leadership Camp is a unique camp with new activities and experiences for teens ages 15-18. This camp offers learn-by-doing leadership development experiences that will enhance and build on campers' leadership knowledge and potential. ___ **STEM Camp** at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp, Jackson (June 10-12)

(Up to 2 recipients selected, must have just completed grades 5-7)

- ☼ Participants will engage in hands-on STEM exploration and learn about how to pursue different careers in STEM. ___ **Camp Canopy: Forestry & Wildlife Conservation Camp** at FFA Camp Muskingum, Carroll County (June 9-14)

(Up to 2 recipients selected, must be at least 15 years old by June and completed the 8th grade)

- ☼ Camp Canopy combines educational sessions with instructors from Ohio's top natural resource organizations (like the Ohio Department of Natural Resources) and industry experts from the state's top educational institutions with the adventure of the great outdoors. There are traditional summer camp activities as well. The trip is sponsored by Monroe County Soil & Water Conservation District. www.campcanopy.com

___ **4-H Space Adventure Camp** at Marietta College, Marietta (June 13-15)

(Up to 2 recipients selected, must be ages 11 to 13 and/or in 5th - 7th grade)

- ☼ Participants will have the opportunity to explore the world of flight and science as they build and test flying machines and computer flight simulations. 4-H space camp is a cooperative venture between the Ohio State University Extension and Marietta College. The three action-packed days include: building and flying hot air balloons, other things that fly, and model rockets. ____ **Ohio 4-H Shooting Junior Education Camp** – ages 9 -12 (June 7-9)

____ **Ohio 4-H Shooting Senior Education Camp** – ages 12 -18 (July 14-19)

(Up to 8 recipients selected)

- ✿ Both camps are held at Canters Cave Camp in Jackson, Ohio. Participants will spend each morning in group and individual instruction in the shooting discipline of their choice: (archery, rifle, shotgun, pistol, & living history). Other activities include: swimming, canoeing, ropes course, rappelling, crafts, fishing and many more. Opportunities to explore other shooting disciplines and learn about leisure activities and issues related to shooting sports is also offered. ____ **Ohio 4-H Sea Camp** at Kelley’s Island 4-H Camp (July 19-23)

(Up to 2 recipients selected, must be at least 15 years old by July)

- ✿ Sea Camp offers teens the opportunity to learn about aquatic science and experience a variety of recreational watersports on Lake Erie. Participants will get an introduction to the Great Lakes through hands-on experiences in a variety of aquatic-based programs, water recreation, and fishing. www.ohio4h.org/camp/sea-camp
